

## DISTRIBUTION LIST FOR COMBINED NOTICES

In general, environmental notices should be sent to all interested parties, including:

- **Local News Media**
- **Individuals and groups interested in your activities, including historical societies and groups**
- **State and Federal agencies, as appropriate**

When a project requires an **Environmental Assessment** to be completed, the State and Federal agencies listed below must receive a copy of the Combined Notice. **Only** submit to Tribes if applicable.

\*If the proposed project involves development or conversion of prime or unique agricultural land for non-agricultural use, submit **ALL NOTICES** (Floodplain/Wetland, NOI/RROF, Combined Notice) to USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service.
