### GOVERNOR'S WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT DIRECTIVE NO. PY 2010-06

**SUBJECT:** Change to Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) Number for Program Year (PY) 2010 Formula Dislocated Worker funds.

- Purpose.** To alert Employment and Training Administration (ETA) grantees of the change to CFDA numbers for existing ETA Dislocated Worker programs beginning in PY 2010 per Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) No. 10-10. (See attached.)
- Discussion.** To provide better transparency and accountability for Federal funds, ETA has split the CFDA number associated with Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Dislocated Worker funds (CFDA number 17.260) into four new CFDA numbers. The new CFDA numbers apply for this PY (2010) and subsequent program years. This change impacts only one of many existing CFDA numbers associated with ETA programs. OMB Circular A-133 and grant agreements require grantees to track, report, and account for funding by CFDA number.
- Action** CFDA number 17.260 WIA Dislocated Workers (DW) will no longer be used on new grants associated with the WIA DW appropriation. For all such grants issued from the WIA DW appropriation after June 30, 2010, the following number will be used: **17.278 WIA Dislocated Worker Formula Grants**

Funds awarded prior to July 1, 2010, will continue to use CFDA number 17.260 during the life of their funds; therefore, no modifications of existing grants will be necessary.

Please ensure all affected sub recipient agreements and Local Area Plans for PY 2010 are updated appropriately to include the revised CFDA number for Dislocated Worker funds. A notification letter listing the affected documents must be submitted to ADECA – Workforce Development Division, attention Mrs. Sara Calhoun, certifying all CFDA numbers have been updated as instructed per TEGL 10-10. It is not mandatory to resubmit Grants or Plans to show the revised CFDA number.

**SUBJECT:** Changes to Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) Numbers

**1. Purpose.** To alert Employment and Training Administration (ETA) grantees of multiple changes to CFDA numbers for existing ETA programs beginning in Program Year (PY) 2010.

**3. Background.** The CFDA (at Internet website URL:<<https://www.cfda.gov/index>>) is maintained by GSA and contains reference numbers for funds appropriated by Congress. The Federal government manages appropriated funding using CFDA numbers. OMB Circular A-133 and grant agreements require grantees to track, report, and account for funding by CFDA number. To provide better transparency and accountability for Federal funds, ETA has split the CFDA number associated with Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Dislocated Worker funds (CFDA number 17.260) into four new CFDA numbers. The new CFDA numbers apply for this PY (2010) and subsequent program years. This change impacts only one of many existing CFDA numbers associated with ETA programs.
